MAILED ABSENTEE BALLOT (apply today) – Prior to October 29th, you may request an absentee ballot online at www.myvote.wi.gov and a ballot will be mailed to you. If you do not have Internet access, you may request an absentee ballot in writing to: City Clerk-Treasurer, 30 East Eau Claire Street, Rice Lake, WI 54868 or via email at kmorse@ricelakegov.org. Your written request must include a copy of your photo ID, address, date of birth, phone number, election date and signature or we will be unable to process your request.

Return mail - allow sufficient mailing time because we must receive your voted ballot on or before November 3rd.

Ballot drop box - place your signed & sealed absentee ballot envelope in the ballot drop box located on the north side of City Hall in the Eau Claire Street parking lot by November 3rd at 8 p.m.

IN-PERSON ABSENTEE BALLOT – Tuesday, October 20, 2020 through Friday, October 30, 2020 from 8 a.m. – 4 p.m. (October 30th until 5 p.m.), you may vote in-person absentee at City Hall, 30 East Eau Claire Street. Social distancing, face coverings and hand sanitizing practices will be used.

ELECTION DAY VOTING – Unless changed by the State of Wisconsin, the City of Rice Lake City Hall polling site will be open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. on November 3rd. Social distancing, face coverings and hand sanitizing practices will be used.
